- No records

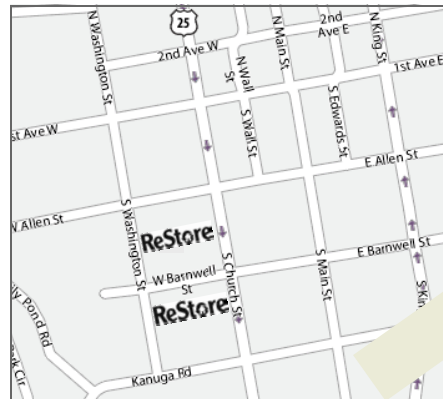
## Plumbing

- Sink - wall mounts must have brackets
- Low flush commodes
- Bathtubs - claw foot, fiberglass or solid surface only
- Hot water heaters - under five years old
- New plumbing supplies
- No marble sink tops - unless attached to cabinet
- No angled counter tops or with sink cut outs

## Sporting Goods

- Quality electric exercise equipment - less than four years old
- Weight benches and iron weights only

## **Donation Guidelines**

This guide is a general outline for the types of donations that Henderson County Habitat for Humanity ReStore will accept. Habitat offers free pickup service for donated items. All merchandise must be in good condition. We prefer that appliances be less than five years old. Donated goods are sold to the community at our two ReStore locations and through our online auction website. The proceeds from the ReStores make up 30% of Henderson County Habitat for Humanity's budget each year. Every donation and every purchase helps continue our mission to end poverty housing in Henderson County.



## **Appliances**

- Stoves and refrigerators in good working condition
- Microwaves less than three years old
- No gas dryers or gas stoves unless properly marked for natural or propane gas.
- No digital wall ovens or countertop ovens

## **Baby Items**

- Most children items will be accepted: however, all donated items must meet current Federal Safety Standards
- Cribs, strollers, swings, baby furniture, car seats, toys and games in good condition

## **Building Supplies**

- Concrete block - all sizes
- Vinyl siding - full boxes
- Shingles - full bundles only
- Lumber - longer than 5 feet, with no nails
- Sheet rock - 4 x 8 sheets
- Insulation - bundled
- Nails and screws
- Cabinets must have all hardware, doors and drawers
- Interior and exterior locks with keys
- Power, hand and garden tools in working condition

## **Doors and Windows**

- Interior - no hollow core luan
- Exterior - good condition
- Sliding glass doors - must be thermal pane and have complete frame
- Storm doors - with complete frame
- Windows - must be thermal pane and have complete frame
- No storm windows

## **Electrical Supplies & Electronics**

- Electrical fixtures and supplies - excellent condition only
- Ceiling fans
- Computers - less than two years old
- Television - less than five years old
- Stereos and speakers
- Copiers - less than three years old and in good working condition
- No can lights

## **Flooring**

- Wood flooring
- New tiles - ceramic, vinyl and carpet
- New vinyl sheet goods - 5 x 8 or larger
- New carpet - 5 x 8 or larger
- Area rugs

## **Furniture**

- Upholstered furniture - without tears, stains, cat scratches or odors
- Wood and metal furniture
- Sectional sofas
- Spinnet pianos only
- Wood desks only - no particle board or metal
- Filing cabinets
- Chairs
- **No mattresses or pillows**
